

# Florida Society of American Foresters

## Nominating Committee Charter

### **Objective:**

The Nominating Committee shall, in accordance with the Bylaws of the Florida Division Society of American Foresters, provide nominees for Florida Division officers who are Society of American Foresters members in good standing for the offices of Chair-Elect and Secretary-Treasurer.

### **Organization:**

The Nominating Committee shall consist of a Chair and two other members. Each committee member shall serve for one year. The Committee Chair may appoint members of the Committee.

### **Activities:**

1. Nominate, from eligible Florida Division members, at least one candidate for the office of Chair-Elect and at least one candidate for the office of Secretary-Treasurer.
2. Advise Florida Division members, by no later than July 1, about the upcoming election and of the provision in Florida Division Bylaws for nominations by the membership at large, if endorsed by at least 25 voting members in good standing.
3. Obtain agreement to serve from each nominee before his/her name is sent to the Florida Division Chair and Secretary-Treasurer.
4. Nominations and agreements, including those from the membership at large, shall be sent to the Florida Division Chair and Secretary-Treasurer by September 15.
5. If, for any reason, a nominee is found by the Florida Division Secretary-Treasurer to be ineligible, the Nominating Committee shall provide another nomination by September 30.
6. If, for any reason, a nominee from the membership at large is found by the Florida Division Secretary-Treasurer to be ineligible, no replacement nominee will be sought.

### **Duration:**

Standing committee appointed for one calendar year

### **Amendments:**

This charter may be amended by a majority vote of the Florida Division Executive Committee.
